- 5. Mike and John have narrowed the search for the company to complete a Reserve Study of Corp 2. They have narrowed it down to 2 companies and will make the decision in the next few weeks.

The CD at Banner bank is set for renewal. McCandless moved, Puente seconded approval of Treasurer's report.

Landscaping:

- 1. The creation of small gardens replacing grass areas seems to be working. These areas will have drought tolerant plants and use a drip system for irrigation.
- 2. A small Olive tree, a large Bird of Paradise, and a small branch will be removed by Atlas Tree Service for \$800. Corp 3 agreed to pay \$200 towards the tree removal that's on both Corporations' property line. Cristofani moved for approval, Puente seconded for the Landscaping report.

New Business:

- 1. The Board agreed that the new Fines process will be a nice clean tool to help the Board do its job to support the CC&R's.
- 2. There was discussion about implementing this tool for the noisy renters' problems.
